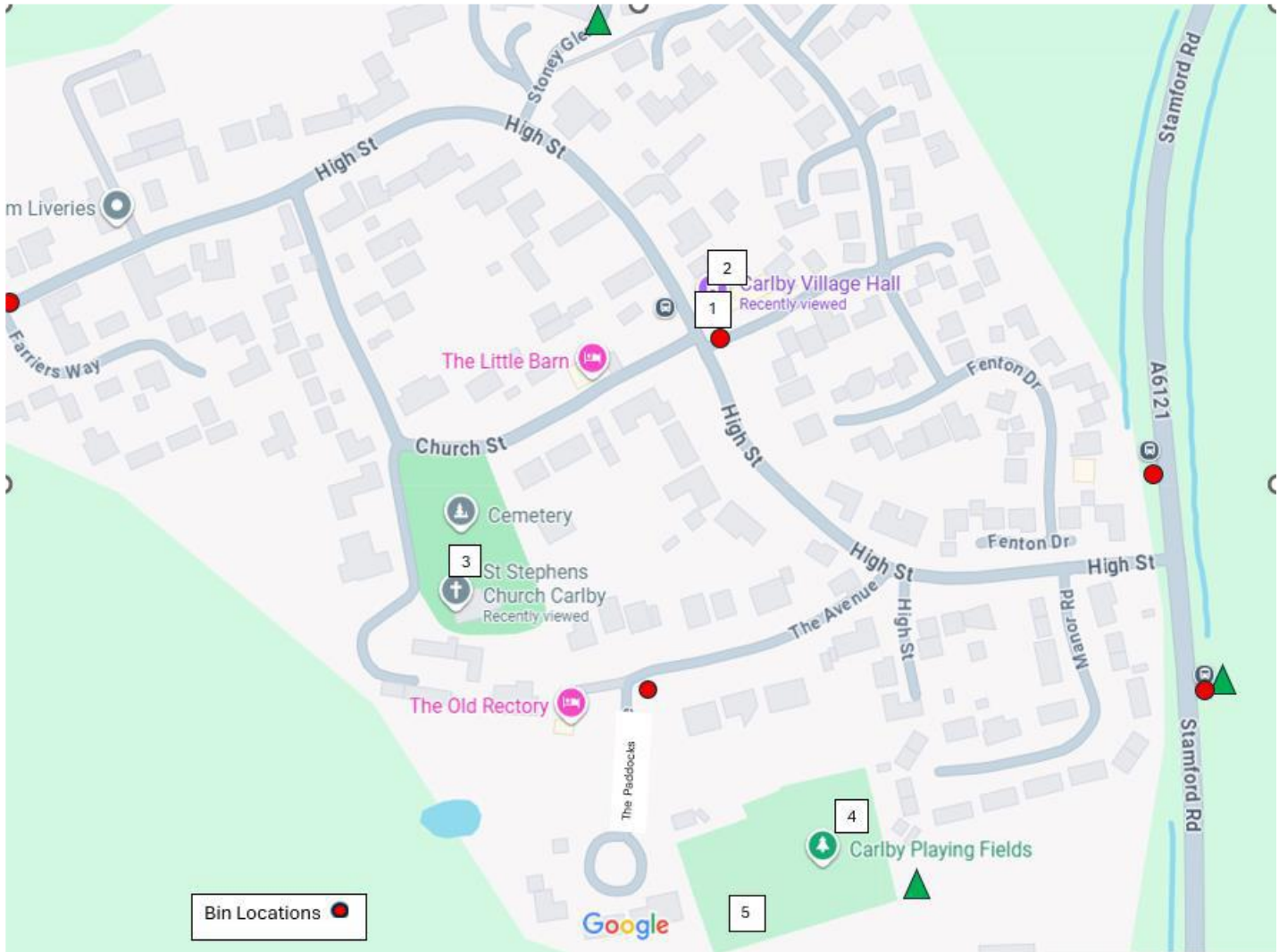

1. Defibrillator. The village Defibrillator is on the left hand side of the village hall door. This unit is regularly checked and monitored by the Parish Council.

Emergency kit. In the case of an emergency or a power outage the Parish Council have an emergency kit stored in the village hall containing a gas heater, camping stove, emergency blanket, torches etc.

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Village Footpaths: ▲

- There is a nice walk from the back of the playing fields, along the river and crossing at the footbridge, here you can head toward Essendine Village or access the fields via a circular permissive route.
- Braceborough Little Wood. Across the A6121 by the bus stop there is a fingerpost and stile this takes you across fields toward Braceborough Wood.
- Dog Kennel Wood loop from Witham on the Hill accessed from Stoney Glen
